Accommodation

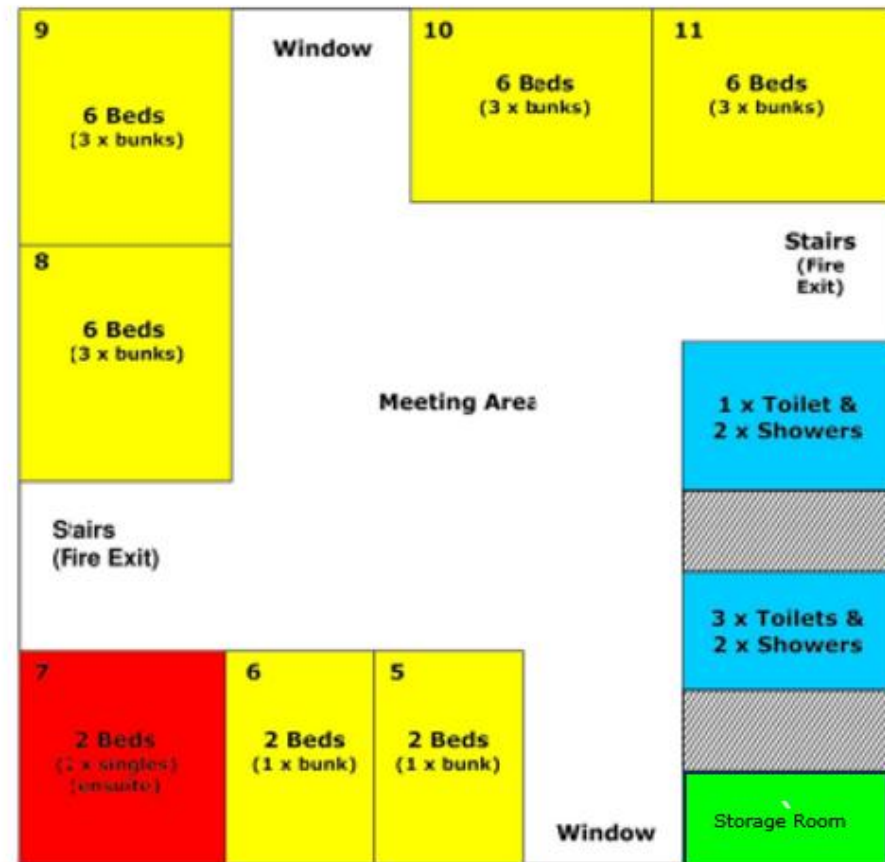


- The children will be sleeping in rooms of between 2-6.

Medical

- We will start collecting medicines a week before departure. Please send these in to the school office.
- Please ensure that any medicines/creams etc., which you have mentioned on the medical form, are given to the school by the day of departure AT THE LATEST.
- These must be clearly labelled with the child's name and instructions for administering.
- If you have given permission for your child to take Calpol, paracetamol etc. on his/her medical form, please provide this.

What the children need to bring:

- Please see kit list.
- Any medicines/creams etc. which parents have mentioned on the medical form.
- Children are also allowed to bring a disposable camera which needs to have their name on it.
- There is a tuck shop on the campus - children can bring £5 only.
- No electronics allowed (phones, gaming devices, etc.)
- Book and soft toy

Payment

To secure your child's place we seek your consent for them to attend and a deposit of £50 by Tuesday 10th March via www.schoolgateway.com

We then offer an instalment plan as follows:

Instalment 1: £50 due by Friday 27th March 2026

Instalment 2: £100 due by Friday 24th April 2026

Instalment 3: £100 due by Friday 22nd May 2026

Alternatively, you can make more regular payments e.g. weekly or pay the outstanding balance of £300 in one payment no later than Friday 22nd May.

Payment

- If for any reason following the meeting you have concerns about your child coming on the trip, or you are unsure about anything, please make an appointment to discuss it with Miss Brown or Miss Turrell.
- If you are entitled to claim free school meals for your child, you may be eligible for a discount towards the cost of your child's trip to Fairthorne Manor. Please contact the office, to discuss the matter further.
